

Collection of Data, Health Insurance

As we understand, Federal Bureau of Statistics (FBS) has been charged with the responsibility of compiling National Health Accounts (NHA) in Pakistan by the Government of Pakistan. NHA methodology organizes, tabulates and presents health spending information in a standard format. NHA mainly deals with the estimation of expenditure on health (both in Public & Private sectors). It is designed particularly as a policy tool for improving the capacity of health sector planners to manage their health systems. NHA allows for comparisons of health expenditures over different periods of time as well as cross country.

2. In the above connection, FBS is interested to know about the quantum of premiums, claims experiences and business acquisition cost in respect of health insurance business in Pakistan. To this effect, all those insurance/takaful companies, engaged in transacting health insurance business, are requested to furnish the required information on the attached format by 21 May 2008, to the undersigned.
