4.	Action Taken	Key findings were reported in the following manner: I have reviewed the facts of the case and considered the written submissions of the Respondent in light of the applicable provisions of the law and states that the Respondent being substantial shareholder of a listed company was required to file Form 6 within the stipulated time period of seven (7) days of the change in the shareholding, in terms of Section 103(1) of the Act and regulation 3(4) of the Regulations. But the Respondent failed to file the said Form 6 within the said prescribed time period, therefore, he is liable to be penalized under Section 106 (2) of the Act. However, keeping in view the fact that the Respondent has disseminated the change in his shareholding structure to PSX and has subsequently filed Form 6 upon coming into his knowledge the said noncompliance and that too prior to any reminder from the Commission, I am of the considered view that said noncompliance on part of the Respondent was not willful and intentional. Therefore, I in terms of the power conferred under Section 106(2) of the Act, hereby conclude the proceedings

		initiated through the SCN without imposing any monetary penalty or any other adverse order.
